Sub: Letter to parents regarding Motor Vehicle Act, 1988

Dear Parents

As you are aware that as per Motor Vehicle Act 1988, no person under the age of 18 years shall drive a motor vehicle in any public place. Hence, as parent it is your duty to comply with the law and not to allow your ward to ride any motor vehicle if he is under the age of 18.

In this respect we would like to communicate to you that it has come to our notice that, despite being aware of such provisions, you have allowed your ward (who is under the age of 18) to drive a motor bike while coming to school. Please note that such an act is violation of the law which not only attracts severe penalty but also may cause a risk to the life of your ward.

Your are therefore advised not to violate the law and don't allow your ward to drive any vehicle especially the motor bike while coming to school, failing of which you will be solely responsible for the consequences of any kind of mishappening and penal provisions.
