Sub: Prevention of driving of vehicles by under-aged students.

Dear Parents,

The incidents of offences by juveniles while driving vehicles are on the rise. In this context, attention of all Parents is brought to the Section 199 A (1 & 2) of 'The Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2019 which states as under:

"199A. (1) Where an offence under this Act has been committed by a juvenile, the guardian of such juvenile or the owner of the motor vehicle shall be deemed to be guilty of the contravention and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.

(2) In addition to the penalty under sub-section (1), such guardian or owner shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years and with a fine of twenty-five thousand rupees.

In view of the above, all the parents are directed to ensure that No student who is underage (Below 18 years of age) and does not hold a valid driving license issued by the Appropriate Authority be permitted to drive any vehicle or commute to and from the School driving any vehicle.

The parents whose wards are above the age of 18 years and are studying at MESCO Public School must submit following:

1. Student's License
2. An undertaking (specimen as under) duly typed on a stamp paper (of Rs. 10/-) attested by a Notary Public / 1st Class Magistrate and submit the same at the school counter.
